The second book of the discovery of America starts also in Egypt, but she leads in western direction from the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic to the Americas.

We follow the Ogam-inscriptions from North-Europe to the area of the St. Lawrence River and till Japan.

The voyage of Pytheas leads us to the high north of Europe, probably till Iceland.

In the voyage of Holy Brandanus we see a description of crossing the Atlantic and a landing on the continent of America. As also that the Vikings, who reached North-America some hundred years later.

A description of the night voyage of the sun in Egypt complete the connection between Europe, Africa and

the Americas on the topic of mysticism.

The "Epos of Gilgamesh", the "Godsongs of the Elder Edda" and the "Divine Comedy" show us further evidences of connections between the Old and the New World. Further it will be shown a comparison between the pyramids of Egypt and Mexico, as also a comparison about findings in the Americas, which are coming from European and African cultures.

The world view of the Catholic Church and the secret knowledge of Christopher Columbus complete the sight of the connections between Europa, Africa and the Americas.
